HOMELANI CAMP AND CONFERENCE CENTER RULES
Updated July 26, 2021

1. The Salvation Army reserves the right to remove any rental group from the premises for its failure, or that of any of its members, to comply with the rules.
2. The Salvation Army is a religious organization and adheres to high standards of morality. The following behaviors are not permitted on the Homelani premises. Nudity in any form, any type of indecent behaviors; sexual contact between unmarried individuals; alcohol; non-prescription narcotics; any unlawful drugs. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in the immediate expulsion of the entire Group.
3. The facilities used by the Rental Group must be kept in safe and sanitary conditions and must be surrendered in as good a condition as received except for normal wear and tear. Failure to maintain the facilities in a safe and sanitary condition may result in the forfeiture of the deposit or additional costs to pay for any damages in excess of the deposit.
4. Pets are not permitted on the grounds except for guide-dogs for the sight impaired.
5. Beach is public property and you swim at your own risk. We highly recommend groups have a certified lifeguard, trained in rescue and emergency procedures, to be on duty at all water-related activities. This individual must be out of the water while guarding and in a position where he/she can continually observe and quickly assist any participant. The aquatic safety system (buddy system, etc.) must be in effect to enable the lifeguard to quickly account for all swimmers.
6. The Quiet Hours at Homelani Camp & Conference Center are from:
8:30 PM – 7:30 AM Sunday – Thursday
9:30 PM – 7:30 AM Friday – Saturday

During the Quiet Hours, none of the following are permitted: excessive sounds, including amplified music or sound systems; organized social functions, such as dances, assemblies, or theatrical productions; organized athletic events; or group outdoor games or related group activities.

7. Use of the Pavilion. Building must be vacated and secured by 10:30 PM. The Quiet Hours requirements must be complied with.
8. Use of outdoor paying field and courts are limited to day light hours, i.e. 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM (i.e. dusk; mealtime). Except for security or safety purposes, lighting shall not be installed in these areas. Further, no outside public address or sound systems are permitted.

9. Smoking is not permitted on the camp grounds except at designated areas. Outdoor cooking is limited to the campfire area only, which is located in the fire pit on the Mauka (mountain) side of the camp grounds.
10. The use of firearms and/or fireworks is prohibited.
11. All vehicles must be parked in the Pavilion parking lot. Vehicles are permitted onto the camp grounds for loading and unloading only. Speed Limit: 5 m.p.h.
12. Due to the proximity of neighbors the flood lights must be extinguished by 10:00 PM.
13. Rental Groups may not sell any merchandise on the Homelani grounds.
14. Recreational Equipment: The following recreational equipment are available upon request: Basketball, Football, Soccer ball, Volleyball, Volleyball Net.
Outdoor activities are permitted between the hours of 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM.
15. Meals. Meal times are set and not subject to change, except for Friday's evening meal.
Breakfast: 8:30 AM Lunch: 12:30 PM Dinner: 5:30 PM
Snack: 9:30 PM (Quiet Hours requirements must be complied with)
16. Multiple Camp Usage. You may be sharing the grounds with other groups. Homelani Camp and Conference Center asks that your group be sensitive to the needs and privacy of others. Quiet Hours times and requirements must be complied with.
17. The Homelani Guest Services Director must approve the final cleaning of the facilities prior to the Rental Group's departure, and the Detail of Camp & Conference Center Rental charges must be completed by the GS Director at that time.
18. Payment must be paid in full by the first day of the rental period.
